



COVID-19 Service attendance information sheet **9th December 2020**

INTRODUCTION – The aim of this sheet is to help you to be able to attend our Church services in a safe manner at this time. Please read it carefully; and be prepared for things to be different and awkward for a time. And, please be patient with those who are serving or helping in any way. Finally, be assured that your safety is our priority.

LOCATION OF OUR SERVICES – Our 8.15am service is held in the Church building AND our 10am service will be held outside in the Church grounds if the weather is fine.

If the weather prohibits us from holding an outdoor service at 10am, we will move the service in to the Church building. Indoor services currently have strict limits on the amount of people who can be in the building. Therefore, if the service moves indoors, we will operate on a “first in, first served” basis. Any who arrive after the limit has been reached, will not be able to attend the service.

When you arrive

- Please try and arrive at least a few minutes before the service as there will be a few procedures that need to be followed.
- Follow directions to the Welcome Desk.
- At all times, maintain 1.5m distance between yourself and those not from your household.
- When you arrive at the Welcome Desk, you will be asked
 - if you have had any COVID-19 related symptoms in the last 14 days. If you have, or you have not yet received a negative result for a COVID test in that time, you will not be able to attend the service
 - to sanitize your hands
 - to scan our QR code and give your name and phone number. If you are unable to do that for any reason, then you will need to give your name and phone number to the person on the welcome desk.



WHAT TO BRING – The following are optional items that you may wish to bring:

- A mask, although they are no longer required for indoor or outdoor services.
- An offering of money. Rather than a collection being taken up, a container will be placed at the Welcome Desk for you to place your money in either before or after the service.
- A Bible, either hard copy or electronic, as Church Bibles won't be able to be used.
- A name tag of some sort. You won't be supplied one at the service.
- 10am service only
 - A CHAIR or picnic rug if the service is outdoors. We will have a limited number of chairs available but cannot guarantee there will be enough for everyone.
 - Any toys, paper, pencils etc for your own children. Church toys, paper, pencils etc will not be available for use.

DURING THE SERVICE

- Please do not shake or touch the hands of others not from your household
- Toilets can be used
- Communion. The 8.15am service will have Communion each Sunday, and the 10am will have it irregularly. At this stage, Communion will be the bread only.
- 10am service only
 - Children are most welcome. Our "Mustard Seeds" children's program has finished for the year, but children are always involved and catered for in our services in different ways.

AFTER THE SERVICE

- There will be no morning tea until further notice.
- You are welcome to stay around and chat, maintaining physical distance between people.
- Take any papers home with you or dispose of them in the bins at the Welcome Desk.
